MEMO

The Hall of Fame event subcommittee met on October 22, 2024.

The subcommittee reviewed the updates discussed at the previous meeting and the final documents are ready for the committee's review, as attached.

TILLSONBURG SPORTS HALL OF FAME PURPOSE & CRITERIA

The Tillsonburg Sports Hall of Fame was proposed by the Recreation and Sports Advisory Committee, a committee of council for the Town of Tillsonburg since October 2003.

1. PURPOSE

The Tillsonburg Sports Hall of Fame recognizes residents who have excelled as athletes, team members, and builders of sport. Eligible nominees include current and former residents with at least two years of residency, as well as non-residents who have made significant contributions to sports in Tillsonburg, at the nominating committee's discretion.

Athletes will generally not be considered for Induction until after three years following their retirement from major championship competition to ensure all their successes have been captured. Nominees will be a minimum age of 18 years at the time of nomination. The Selection Committee may choose to waive this waiting period or age requirement if they feel the athlete deserves immediate recognition.

A sport shall be defined as an athletic activity recognized as such by the Tillsonburg Hall of Fame Committee. The committee will primarily refer to sports acknowledged by national and international governing bodies, including but not limited to Sport Canada and International Olympic Committee. The Committee reserves the right to periodically review and update the list of recognized sports as necessary.

2. CRITERIA

Athlete Criteria

Must have participated successfully in a local, regional, provincial, national, international, amateur, professional, sanctioned, or non-sanctioned sport, having performed in such a way as an individual or member of a team, to bring special honour to Tillsonburg.

Selection Criteria – Athlete:

- Consideration will be given to records set, number and significance of awards won, skill and ability levels and the standards achieved.
- In good standing in their sport and community at the time of the selection process.
- Higher than average proficiency in more than one sport.
- Athletes shall be eligible for nomination after having retired for three years from active participation in the sport or sports involved at their highest level of participation;

Team Criteria

Must have attained a high level of excellence and brought honour to Tillsonburg sport at a local, regional, provincial, national, international, amateur, professional, sanctioned, or non-sanctioned level. Teams are selected for achievement in one year only.

Selection Criteria – Team:

- Teams that have won a championship or title at the regional, provincial, national or international level in a given year.
- Consideration will be given to records set, number and significance of award at all levels.
- Teams are selected for achievement in one year only.

Builder Criteria

A builder must have demonstrated consistently outstanding commitment and leadership to athletics or sports as a coach, official, executive, manager, trainer, administrator, teacher, sponsor or volunteer, over an extended period of time (minimum 5 years). Any person nominated in the builder category shall be eligible at any time, as that person might be active in their role over an entire lifetime. Must have attained a high level of excellence and brought recognition to Tillsonburg through on-going dedication to the development of athletes, teams, or sport itself. Said builder must have, at the time of the achievement represented a Tillsonburg sporting body. Builder nominees who contribute to sport in Tillsonburg, whether or not the builder is a resident, will be considered.

Selection Criteria - Builder:

- A builder may be active or inactive at the time of nomination.
- Consideration given to integrity, sportsmanship and character providing inspiration to present and future generations
- Complied an outstanding record of coaching/managing championship teams and or athletes, and compiled an extraordinary winning record or have achieved other outstanding accomplishments.
- Attained a high level of excellence and brought honour and recognition to Tillsonburg sport and sport history.
- Nominees exhibit a "pioneering" quality in athletic, builder, or team accomplishments, involving some aspect of innovation, or trailblazing that changed the shape of sport in Tillsonburg.
- The nominees work must have been of a consistently high level with regard to services provided or results achieved.
- Positive impact in the community.
- Contribution back to the community of Tillsonburg, either in their sport or beyond their specific sport.

3. NOMINATION FORM

See attached sheets.

4. SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Selection Committee will consist of members of the Recreation and Sports Advisory Committee with staff support from the Recreation, Culture & Parks Department.

5. NUMBER OF INDUCTEES

The number of inductees will be limited to a maximum number of:

Teams – 2

Individuals – 4

Builders – 4

Note: It is not necessary to have one inductee in each category per induction.

6. RECOGNITION

Inductees will be recognized in the following manner:

- a. Bi-Annual induction ceremony, or upon need;
- b. Press release of the event in the local newspaper; and,
- c. Display of wall plaque with picture and bio for each inductee at the Tillsonburg Community Centre.

7. ADMINISTRATION

Administration of the Tillsonburg Sports Hall of Fame, including record keeping and actual site determination, will be provided by the Recreation Culture and Parks Department.
